REFERENCE FIGURE 1 OR ZEEN MANUAL FOR HANDLEBAR STRAP ANATOMY AND PART NAMES

NOTE: Be sure that the left and right straps are correctly oriented from the user's point of view.

Step 1) Separate the velcro tabs at the top of the webbing loop, shown open in Figure 1..

Step 2) Position the webbing loop around the metal brake lever as seen in Figure 2.

Step 3) Pull up and around the handlebar like in Figures 3 & 4 until you get to the joint of the plastic above the junction of the metal tube, as seen in Figure 5.

Step 4) Overlap the Velcro tabs across the top ridged surface of the plastic as seen in Figure 6.

Step 5) Disengage and fold the handlebar using the locking lever at the pivot, shown in Figure 7.

Step 6) Feed the strap underneath the backrest, like in Figure 8 around the tube from the inside.

NOTE: Keep the strap straight, facing the bump of the webbing in the tri-glide away from the user.

Step 7) Push the end of the strap through the back of the tri-glide as seen in Figure 9.

Step 8) Bend strap end over, feed through the front of the tri-glide, and pull tight, as in Figure 10.

NOTE: Position of the tri-glide along the strap will determine the final handlebar positioning

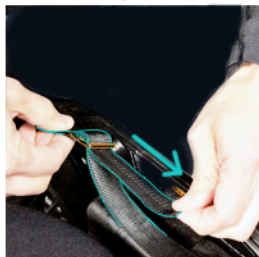
